



## “Rope for the World” Rules & Regulations

- 1. DIVISIONS:** 5 and Under, 6-8 years old, 9-12 years old. **Boys** and **Girls** compete together. Age is determined by the age of the child on the day of the roping competition.
- 2. ENTRY FEE:** \$\_\_\_\_\_
- 3. EQUIPMENT:** Contestants are to provide their own ropes.  
Roping dummy is provided by: [www.RopeSmart.com](http://www.RopeSmart.com)
- 4. FORMAT:** Ropers must stand behind clearly established barrier line to throw loop. Stepping over line before the try is completed will be considered a missed try. **No fishing is allowed.** **Fishing** is defined as not immediately pulling the slack after the throw of the rope. Contestants are not allowed to rope the entire dummy. Line judge may alter format.  
In Round 1, each contestant will throw two loops. Those catching with both loops will advance to the Sudden Death Reach Contest. Distance and/or horn size may be changed each round thereafter until the winners are determined.
- 5. LEGAL CATCHES:**  
5 and under and 6-8 year old division: there are three (3) legal catches: around the horns, half head and around the neck.  
9-12 year old division: contestants must rope slick horns only. No figure eights or hickies on horns allowed in either division.
- 6. DISQUALIFICATION:** Ropers will be expected to step to barrier line and be ready to compete when name is called. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Stepping over the line is also a disqualification.
